



Zippo lighters BACK ON BOARD!

YES

Lighters in the passenger cabin are permitted.

In August 2007, the Transportation Safety Administration (TSA) lifted their ban on Zippo lighters from inside passenger cabins of commercial aircraft.



YES

Previously fueled Zippo lighters CAN BE PUT in checked luggage.

In June 2005, the Department of Transportation (DOT) issued an exemption for previously fueled Zippo lighters in checked luggage. The new ruling allows passengers to pack up to two previously fueled Zippo pocket lighters – in an approved case – in checked luggage aboard all commercial airlines. The Zippo Cargo Case and Zippo Air Case are both approved cases. To order, visit zippo.com.

New, never fueled Zippo lighters CAN BE PUT in checked luggage.

In May 2005, the DOT ruled that Zippo lighters, which have never been fueled, can be placed in checked luggage.
